4.1(a)	This states that the Business Improvement Exception is relevant when the organization has developed a product or has an existing product that it is enhancing. Is there a deliberate intention to exclude the situation where the organization is developing new goods or services (as covered under "relevant purposes" by the PDPA Schedule 1 Part 5 paragraph 1(2)(a))?
4.1	Does the Business Improvement Exception and Research exception using AI is applicable to a Singapore incorporated bank's customer personal data who is is subject to Banking Act, section 47
5.1	To clarify if consent is not required when using "Business improvement and research" exception, for AI to share PI with different Legal entities including cross border entities of the same parent company
5.4	Can the Guidelines provide an example of AI System development to provide new goods/ products or services?

7.2	The Guidelines states that privacy controls for 'internal use' need not be extensive as intra-group or cross- company sharing. (a) Does this mean that corporate recipients of such data need to have more stringent privacy controls when using such data, compared to the company they received such data from? If so, what's the rationale for this? (b) Does 'internal use' simply refer to the organization using personal data without transferring it to other companies? Or does it refer to the organization using personal data for internal purposes e.g. internal operations, and not for goods and services provided to external customers?
9.1 / 9.2 / 9.4	To clarify if additional specific AI processing clause is required in a customer consent for the use/ processing of personal data in AI
9.5(d)	This requires organisations to tell customers what are the specific features of personal data that influence the product feature. However this could be challenging because an organization is likely to refine its AI System over time. Through such iterations of testing and learning, the relevant specific features of personal data that are more influential might also change over time. It would be challenging for the organization to keep notifying its customers about such changes in specific features.
