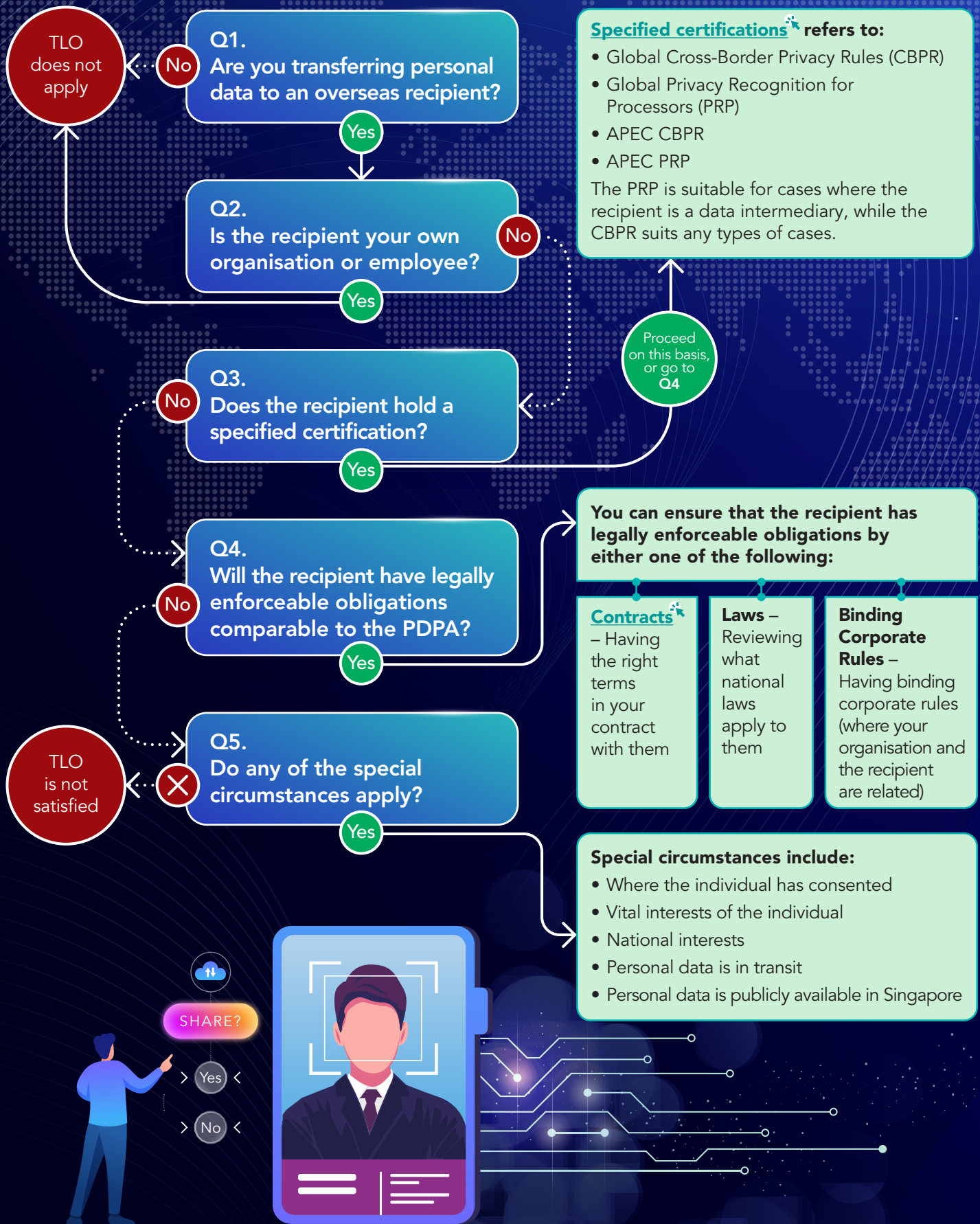


Meeting The Transfer Limitation Obligation (TLO)



Specified certifications refers to:

- Global Cross-Border Privacy Rules (CBPR)
- Global Privacy Recognition for Processors (PRP)
- APEC CBPR
- APEC PRP

The PRP is suitable for cases where the recipient is a data intermediary, while the CBPR suits any types of cases.

Proceed on this basis, or go to Q4

You can ensure that the recipient has legally enforceable obligations by either one of the following:

Contracts

– Having the right terms in your contract with them

Laws

– Reviewing what national laws apply to them

Binding Corporate Rules

– Having binding corporate rules (where your organisation and the recipient are related)

Special circumstances include:

- Where the individual has consented
- Vital interests of the individual
- National interests
- Personal data is in transit
- Personal data is publicly available in Singapore
